

THE AJE EVOLUTION

Aoba-Japan Extension has been transforming itself over the past several years. Here's a snapshot of how the communicative learning program has grown, and what's coming up for their 2018 Summer Camp

2013

Aoba-Japan's innovative **Extension Program (AJE)** launches. They begin offering **Camps**, and three years later start up their **Saturday** and **After School** programs.

2018

AJE introduces **After School Programs in Tokyo**, offering lessons in Mitaka from Monday to Friday, and featuring eight different classes delivered to two age groups (3-4 and 5-8 years old). The program includes hip hop and cheer dance, ballet, soccer, and courses in English Skills, science, and technology.

4-18

The **age range** of students who attend AJE's programs. All programs are open to Aoba-Japan students as well as the general public, while the seasonal camps also welcome international students.

12

The number of **soccer teams** that take part in AJE's annual **U12 Nadia-Tohoku International Soccer Friendly**. This event supports the Nadia charity, which provides hope for victims of the Tohoku 2011 earthquake, with this year's games scheduled for mid-June.

5

The number of **seasonal camps** now run by AJE, including spring, summer, winter, and two sports camps. Also the number of weeks in their inspiring and immersive summer program held at their Hikarigaoka campus

4

The number of locations of the popular **Action Saturday School**, which launched in 2017. Currently offered in Meguro, Waseda, Motoazabu, and Mitaka, with plans to expand to 10 locations.

The dates for AJE's upcoming Kids & Teens Summer Camp, AJE's flagship program. This year, the theme is "A Rockin' Summer," and popular Californian band Beta State will take part in the Teens Camp, teaching students how to produce their own rock video, and will also be performing live at the AJE Camp Finale on August 24.
